



How to get your EYMS Scarborough TEC Bus Pass

Go to Google Play or the App Store and search for 'EYMS Buses' – download the app to your phone (it's free!). Do this on the day of enrolment if you can, or as soon as possible afterwards. **If you don't download the app by 9am on Friday 31st August, your pass may not be ready for the start of term and you will have to pay for bus fares until it is ready, with no refunds available.**

It is important to note - if you have already downloaded the EYMS Buses app in the past, you'll need to update the app to make sure you have the most recent version.

Don't have an Apple or Android smartphone? Please contact the Student Services Team at Scarborough TEC as soon as possible.

Fully funded passes

New students can apply for a fully funded pass. Please visit the Transport Desk at enrolment or complete the Student Transport eligibility form and return with supporting evidence to bursary@scarboroughtec.ac.uk before 31st August.

Continuing students can also apply for a fully funded pass. Students must complete a Student Transport eligibility form and return it to the Transport Desk at our Filey Road Campus on 23rd, 24th or 28th August or email the form with the appropriate evidence attached to bursary@scarboroughtec.ac.uk before 31st August.

All students should download the app, using the email address given on the eligibility form. EYMS will create an app account for you with your free ticket in. EYMS will send you an email when it's in your account, which will tell you how to finish setting up your ticket – **it is important you look out for this email.**

For paying students (discounted Scarborough TEC pass)

On the EYMS Buses app menu, tap 'Mobile Tickets' and choose the 'Scarborough TEC' section. Choose the appropriate ticket. Scarborough TEC staff can advise you which ticket to get if you are unsure. Choose the ticket, and tap 'create an account'. **Make sure the email address you sign up with is your Scarborough TEC email address (make sure you check the spelling!)** or the address the college have for you, and choose a password, then click 'Sign up'. You must put in a valid credit/debit card to pay, or you can pay using Apple Pay. You'll also have to upload a photo, which you can take using your phone – make sure it's a sensible photo! **You must do this by 9am on Friday 31st August.** Your ticket will be validated and ready to use on your device by the first day of term.

On the first day you're going to travel, activate the ticket, and then simply show the pass on your device to the bus driver when you board the bus. If you don't sign up to the app and choose your ticket by the deadline, your pass may not be ready for the start of term and you will have to pay for bus fares until it is ready, with no refunds available.

The EYMS Buses app gives you the ability to plan journeys, buy bus tickets and find out real-time information on bus disruptions, so will be very useful as your travel around the area.

EYMS Transport Zones

Ticket zones	Area covered
Scarborough zone term ticket (£88 per term)	Scarborough, Eastfield, Cayton, Seamer.
Network wide term ticket (£268 per term)	All EYMS and Scarborough and District buses, including 12, 13, 128. Excludes contract services and Park and Ride.
Town centre to campus ticket (£78 per term)	Includes all standard EYMS and Scarborough and District buses between Scarborough Town Centre and Scarborough TEC campus on Filey Road. Includes Services 7, 7A, 12, 13. Not valid on Park and Ride.
P&R ticket (£48 per term)	Valid on Scarborough Park and Ride only between Filey Road Park & Ride and Filey Road Campus.

Term dates:

- Term 1:** 4th September 2018 – 20th December 2018
- Term 2:** 8th January 2019 – 12th April 2019
- Term 3:** 29th April 2019 to 28th June 2019
- Annual tickets:** 4th September 2018 – 28th June 2019

Reminder

If you don't download the app by 9am on Friday 31st August, your pass may not be ready for the start of term and you will have to pay for bus fares until it is ready, with no refunds available.
