EARLY YEARS AVAILABLE AT LEVELS 2 & 3

A T Level in early years will open the door to a world of possibilities.

This hugely important vocation could see you play a part in creating the foundations of a child's behaviour, education and aspirations.

If you have a natural affinity with children, and want to develop that into a career, then our early years course will equip you with all the practical skills required to progress in to a job.

You will study child development and communication as well as working with children in a variety of roles. The course will cover child health, playing and learning, safeguarding, craft activities and supporting children's learning literacy and numeracy in the early stages.

Work experience plays a huge part on this course with placements available in nurseries and schools, all of which will enhance your learning experience and build your confidence, readying you for the workplace.

Level 2

Entry requirements

Students should hold a minimum of a Level 1 in your chosen subject or at least 4 GCSE's at grade 2/3. Applicants must also hold a clear DBS check.

Level 3

Entry requirements

Students should hold a minimum of a Level 2 in the chosen subject or at least 4 GCSE's at grade 9/4 (A*-C) or equivalent, including English and Mathematics. They must also hold a clear DBS.

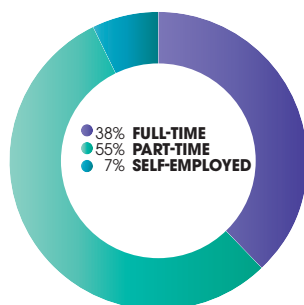
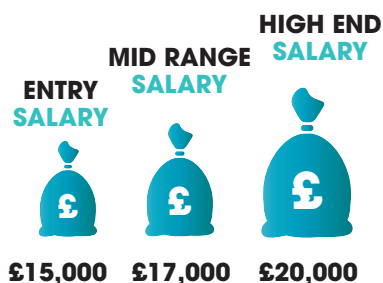

WORK PLACEMENTS

Throughout Levels 2 and 3 you will be required to complete work placements as part of the T Level programme. This will include a minimum of 250 hours at Level 2 and a minimum of 380 hours at Level 3.

English & Maths

If you haven't achieved a GCSE Grade 4 (C) in English and/or Maths you will be required to either; take a Functional Skills qualification if you have achieved a Grade 1 or 2, or retake the GCSE if you've achieved Grade 3. You will be fully supported by our specialist team ahead of taking the exam.
