WHAT NEXT?

During your course we ensure you develop employability skills and gain relevant experience. We provide information, advice and support when completing your course and progressing to work or going into higher education. When applying for university we can provide support with the UCAS application and Student Finance. These qualifications give you the foundations to begin a career in hairdressing or barbering, or to advance in your career by gaining new skills.

ENGLISH & MATHS

If you haven't achieved a GCSE Grade 4 in English and/or Maths you will be required to either; take a Functional Skills qualification if you have achieved a Grade 1 or 2, or retake the GCSE if you've achieved Grade 3. You will be fully supported by our specialist team ahead of taking the exam.

HOW IS THIS COURSE ASSESSED?

These courses are assessed through a series of assignments and subject evidence provided through the building of a portfolio. The course is also assessed through a series of observations and examinations and, at Level 3, a mandatory work placement will take place.

HAIRDRESSING

Hairdressing is more than just styling, you need to keep up with the latest trends and techniques in this fast-paced industry and having a strong foundation and skillset is essential in doing this.

While working in our state-of-the-art professional salon, Image, you will develop skills in shampooing, conditioning, styling, colouring, cutting and perming hair all of which are essential in gaining employment or when working on a self-employed basis.

Competition can be fierce so you need to set yourself apart from the rest of the crowd. Male grooming is also an ever-increasing industry and experienced, creative barbers are more in demand than ever. With many other careers and industry areas disappearing from the high street as a result of the rise in digital markets, hairdressing and barbering is one career that cannot be delivered online.

Work experience could include working on fashion shoots, theatre productions and involvement in competitions, both locally and nationally. Image is open to the public so you'll have the chance to work with a wide range of clientele enabling you to practice treatments and hone not just your practical skills but areas like customer service skills, handling money and stock control.

At Level 1 you will study for a joint Hairdressing and Beauty Therapy qualification before specialising from Level 2.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Level 1 entry - You will require GCSEs grade 1 or equivalent, including Foundation Awards and Entry Level Certificates. You must also work towards an Entry Level 3 qualification in Functional Skills.

Level 2 entry - You will require a minimum of 4 GCSEs grade 4 or above including Maths and English language. A minimum of Level 1 course in chosen subject at Merit or above and Level 1 in English Language and Maths.

Level 3 entry - You will require a minimum of 5 GCSEs grade 3 or above including Maths and/or English language and relevant subject qualification or a Level 2 course in chosen subject at Merit or above and Level 2 English Language and Maths.

WHAT WILL YOU STUDY?

At Level 1 you could study:

- Hand care
- Skin care
- Nail art and shampooing
- Make-up application and face painting
- Women's hair styling
- Using colour to create an image
- Consultation and customer service skills.

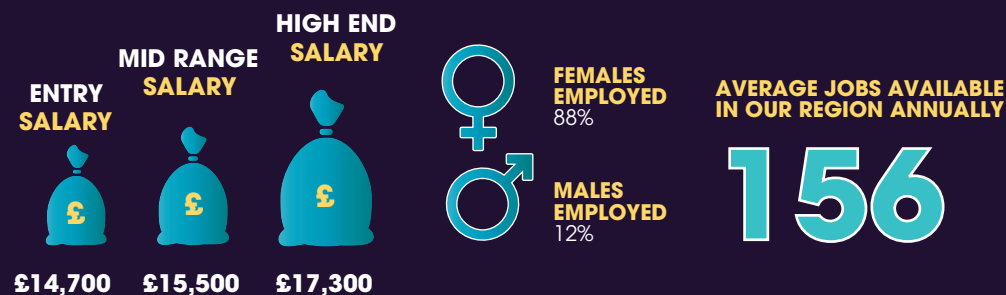
At Level 2 you could study:

- Cutting women's hair
- Colouring and lightening hair
- Cutting men's hair
- Hairdressing reception duties
- Perming
- Plaiting and twisting.

At Level 3 you could study:

- Monitor and maintain health and safety practice in the salon
- Consultation support for colleagues on hair services
- Style and dress hair using a variety of techniques
- Cut women's hair to create a variety of looks
- Colour hair to create a variety of looks
- Human resource management
- Perm hair to create a variety of looks
- Hair extensions services
- Make and style a hair addition
- Bridal hair
- Style and finish
- Promote and sell products and services to clients
- Hair colour correction.
