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Course entry requirements

There really is a course for everyone here at Scarborough TEC. Offering a wide range of vocational, college-based courses, apprenticeships and T Levels, all of our course entry requirements will vary depending on the level of the course.

What does that mean for you?

Simply choose your course based on what you want to do, and we will help and support you to enrol onto the right level for you – we will talk you through it all when you apply.

Level 1	3 GCSEs at grade 2 or above*
Level 2	3 GCSEs at grade 3 or above, preferably including either English or maths*
Level 3	4 GCSEs at grade 4 or above, including English and maths*

*Please note these are a guideline to entry, speak to us if you have any questions.

GCSE English & maths

Whatever your chosen career path, employers across the board will have a requirement for you to have passed your GCSE English & maths.

Need help getting there? Don't worry, if you haven't achieved a grade 4/C in these core subjects, we will support you and help you to re-sit these exams, whilst you are studying with us.

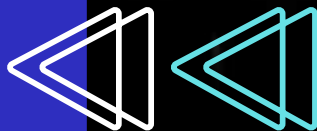

Need a ride to get to Scarborough TEC? No worries with our **FREE** bus travel.

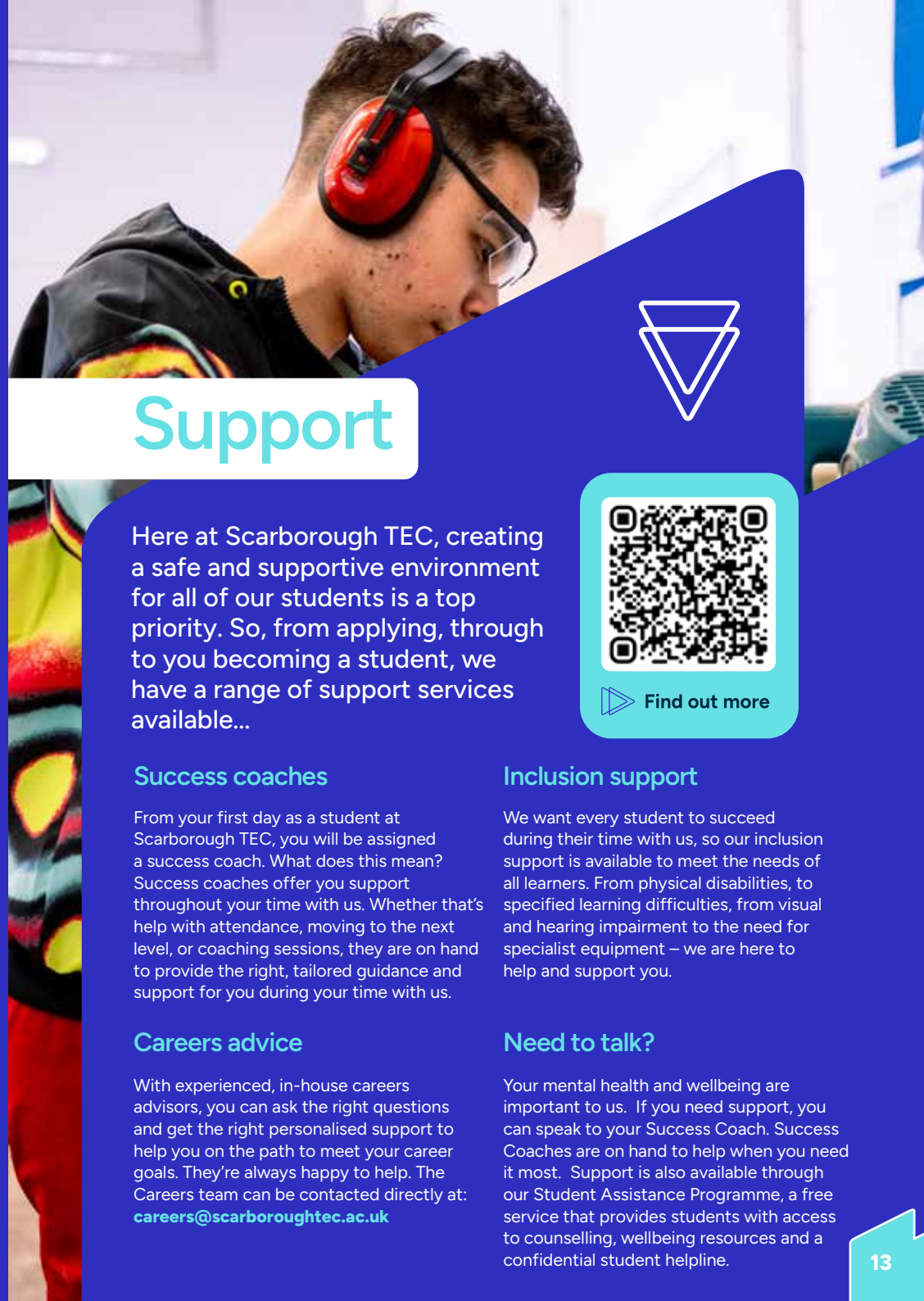
For all students aged 16-18 who are eligible to access a bursary we are able to offer free travel, using local transport service, providing you live 1.5 miles or more away.

Students must have an annual household income of less than £45,000 and be training on one of our full-time courses.

Any student who is not eligible or who is 19+ and studying on a full-time course will be eligible for a discounted ticket on their chosen bus route.

- They are made up of 80% classroom time with 20% in the workplace and last for two years
- Worth the same number of UCAS points as three A Levels
- A qualification to help you progress to an apprenticeship or degree.
